- **HEALTH CARE**

A unit of 149 technical and nonprofessional employees at LIVINGSTON HEALTHCARE in Livingston, Mont., April 29 voted 103-23 against representation by the AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES, MONTANA COUNCIL 9. The National Labor Relations Board May 10 certified the results of the election as a loss for the union.

- **HEALTH CARE**

A unit of 157 paramedics, emergency medical technicians, and dispatchers at AMERICAN MEDICAL RESPONSE OF COLORADO INC. in Denver, Golden, Boulder, and Longmont, Colo., April 29 voted 103-45 against representation by the NATIONAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES ASSOCIATION. The National Labor Relations Board May 10 certified the results of the election as a loss for the union.

- **HEALTH CARE**

The National Labor Relations Board May 25 certified the SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION HEALTH CARE FLORIDA as the bargaining agent for a unit of 213 registered nurses at NORTHSIDE HOSPITAL & TAMPA BAY HEART INSTITUTE in St. Petersburg, Fla. Results of the May 12 decertification election showed employees voted 110-28 for continued representation by SEIU.

- **MANUFACTURING**

The National Labor Relations Board April 20 certified the UNITED STEELWORKERS as the bargaining agent for a unit of 135 production and maintenance employees at CENVEO CORP. in Altoona, Pa. Results of the April 8 election showed employees voted 104-28 for the union.

- **SERVICES**

The National Labor Relations Board May 13 certified UNITED FOOD AND COMMERCIAL WORKERS LOCAL 371 as the bargaining agent for a unit of

125 parking lot attendants, cashiers, maintenance staff, and valets at PRO PARK INC. in Stanford, Conn. after it determined that the challenges to ballots of 14 shuttle drivers should be sustained. Results of the April 27 election showed employees voted 65-45 for the union.

• **TRANSPORTATION**

A unit of 132 drivers, mechanics, maintenance employees, aides, monitors, and attendants at FIRST STUDENT INC. in Wood River Junction, R.I., May 7 voted 66-57 against continued representation by INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS LOCAL 251. The National Labor Relations Board May 17 certified the results of the decertification election as a loss for the union.

• **TRANSPORTATION**

The National Labor Relations Board May 24 certified INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS LOCAL 683 as the bargaining agent for a unit of 401 drivers, mechanics, and service workers at VEOLIA TRANSPORTATION SERVICES INC. in Chula Vista, Calif. Results of the May 14 election showed employees voted 281 for LOCAL 683, which intervened in the election, 28 for AMALGAMATED TRANSIT UNION LOCAL 1309, the incumbent union, and five for no union.
