- **AUTOMOBILES**

A unit of 142 rental sales agents, service agents, staff assistants, cashiers, dispatchers, and greeters at DOLLAR THRIFTY AUTOMOTIVE GROUP INC. at Orlando International Airport June 11 voted 89-40 against representation by INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS LOCAL 385. The National Labor Relations Board June 30 certified the results of the election as a loss for the union.

- **AEROSPACE**

A unit of 137 inspectors, mechanics, electricians, painters, firefighters, and technicians, among other warehouse employees, at CSC APPLIED TECHNOLOGY LLC in Killeen, Texas, June 3 voted 91-41 against representation by the INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF MACHINISTS. The National Labor Relations Board June 11 certified the results of the election as a loss for the union.

- **CONSTRUCTION**

The National Labor Relations Board June 25 certified INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS LOCAL 357 as the bargaining agent for a unit of 199 wiremen, technicians, cable splicers, and apprentices at HENKELS & MCCOY INC. in Clark, Lincoln, and Nye counties, Nev. In a June 17 election, employees voted 118-0 for representation by the union.

- **ENTERTAINMENT**

The National Labor Relations Board June 16 certified UNITE HERE LOCAL 23 as the bargaining agent for a unit of 665 vendors, helpers, cashiers, attendants, and bartenders employed by ARAMARK SPORTS LLC at Coors Field in Denver. Results of the June 7 election showed that 172 employees voted for LOCAL 23, the incumbent union, 34 voted for WORKERS UNITED LOCAL 14, an affiliate of SERVICE EMPLOYEES INTERNATIONAL UNION, which intervened, and two voted for no union.

- **HEALTH CARE**

A unit of 141 nurses' aides, resident assistants, housekeepers and maintenance workers at LUTHERAN ORPHANS AND OLD FOLKS HOME SOCIETY AT WOLF CREEK INC. in Toledo, Ohio, June 4 voted 75-51 in favor of representation by UNITED FOOD AND COMMERCIAL WORKERS LOCAL 75. The National Labor Relations Board June 15 certified the results of the election as a win for the union.

- **TRANSPORTATION**

The National Labor Relations Board June 18 certified OREGON SCHOOL EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION LOCAL 6732 as the bargaining agent for a unit of 107 drivers and driver trainers at FIRST STUDENT INC. in Gresham, Ore. Results of the June 10 election showed that 67 employees voted for LOCAL 6732, the incumbent union, six voted for INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS LOCAL 206, which intervened, and 25 voted for no union.

- **TRUCKING**

A unit of 102 production, maintenance, and warehouse employees at SPARTECH PLASTICS LLC in Greenville, Ohio, May 27 voted 59-33 against representation by INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS LOCAL 957. The National Labor Relations Board June 4 certified the results of the election as a loss for the union.
